OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND RETAIL CAKE, CONFECTIONERY, DAIRY, FRUIT, AND VEGETABLE SHOP ASSISTANTS.— AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Retail Cake, Confectionery, Dairy, Fruit, and Vegetable Shop Assistants' award, dated the 24th day of June, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 938.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:----

(1) By deleting clause 3, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

"Thereafter, not less than £4 6s. per week."

(2) By deleting clause 4, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

" Casual Workers

"4. Casual hands shall be paid not less than 3s. 10d. per hour in the case of adult males, 2s. 8d. per hour in the case of junior males, 2s. $8\frac{1}{2}$ d. per hour in the case of adult females, and 2s. $1\frac{2}{3}$ d. per hour in the case of junior females." (3) By deleting clause 5 (Increase in Rates of Remuneration).

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
