OTAGO TEA-PACKING EMPLOYEES (FEMALE).—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of Otago Tea-packing Employees' (Female) award, dated the 23rd day of December, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 2203.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:-
- (1) By deleting clause 5, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

" Wages

"5. The minimum weekly rates of wages shall be as follows:-

- (2) By deleting clause 6 (Increase in Rates of Remuneration).
- 2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
