DUNEDIN CITY COUNCIL WATERWORKS' CARETAKERS.— AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Dunedin City Council Waterworks' Caretakers' award, dated 6th day of October, 1943, and recorded in 43 Book of Awards 499.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 23rd day of August, 1945) shall be further amended in the manner following:—
- (1) By deleting subclause (f) of clause 9 (Remuneration of Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—
- "(f) The following shall be the minimum wages payable to all employees specified in the following schedule:—
