WELLINGTON CITY COUNCIL LABOURERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Wellington City Council Labourers' award dated the 23rd day of December, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 2337.
