## NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT BRICK, TILE, AND POTTERY WORKERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Brick, Tile, and Pottery Workers' award, dated the 2nd day of May, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 657.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—
  (1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—
- "(a) The minimum wage for an adult male worker shall be £6 8s. 9d. per week: Provided that such a worker whose employment is for five consecutive working-days or less shall be classed as a casual and paid a minimum rate of 3s.  $2\frac{1}{2}$ d. per hour."

(2) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 4 (Youths), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

"(a) Male workers under twenty-one years of age shall be paid in accordance with the following scale:—
