

AUCKLAND HOSPITAL BOARD **LABOURERS AND GARDENERS.**—  
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Auckland Hospital Board Labourers and Gardeners' award, dated the 31st day of July, 1945, and recorded in 45 Book of Awards 951.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting clause 3, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

*“Wages*

“3. The following shall be the minimum rates of wages:—

“(a) (i) Where eight or more gardeners and/or groundsmen are substantially employed—

“Senior man .. ..	3	7½
“First assistant gardener ..	3	5½
“Second assistant gardener ..	3	4½
“All others .. ..	3	2½

“(ii) Where five to seven gardeners and/or groundsmen are substantially employed—

“Senior man .. ..	3	6
“One assistant gardener ..	3	4½
“All others .. ..	3	2½

“(iii) Where two to four gardeners and/or groundsmen are substantially employed—

“Senior man .. ..	3	6
“All others .. ..	3	2½

“(iv) Where one only gardener and/or groundsman is substantially employed .. ..

3 4½

“At the Green Lane Hospital the men employed in the vegetable garden shall be treated as a separate gang.

“(b) Groundsmen when employed on scythe-work or a motor-mower, and ploughmen .. 3 3½

“(c) Labourers permanently attached to engineers’ and plumbers’ departments .. 3 5½

“(d) Incinerator attendants, rat-catcher, and drain-cleaner .. .. 3 5½

“(e) Other general workers not specified above 3 2½”

(2) By deleting clause 5 (Increase in Rates of Remuneration).

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
