HAWKE'S BAY FRUIT-PACKERS, FRUIT-GRADERS, AND FRUIT COOL-STORE WORKERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Hawke's Bay Fruit-packers, Fruit-graders, and Fruit Cool-store Workers' award, dated the 13th day of August, 1941, and recorded in 41 Book of Awards 978.
