

NEW ZEALAND (EXCEPT WESTLAND) **FARM MACHINERY SERVICEMEN.**—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand (except Westland) Farm Machinery Servicemen award, dated the 8th day of April, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 585.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting clause 6, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“ *Wages*

“ 6. (a) The minimum rate for adult workers shall be £7 2s. 9d. per week.

“ (b) *Youths.*—Youths may be employed as assistants to adults in the proportion of one youth to the first two adult workers and one to each additional three adult workers employed in any district by the same employer, and shall be paid the following minimum weekly rates of wages:—

Age commencing.	First Six Months.	Second Six Months.	Third Six Months.	Fourth Six Months.	Fifth Six Months.	Sixth Six Months.
18 years or under ..	73/6	79/-	90/-	101/6	113/-	126/6
19 years	92/6	101/6	113/-	126/6
20 years	113/-	126/6

“ And thereafter the adult rate.”

(2) By deleting clause 7 (Increase in Rates of Remuneration).

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1947.
