IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the New Zealand Private Hotels' Employees' award, dated the 23rd day of December, 1946 (1946 Book of Awards 2405), this Court doth hereby order as follows:—
