

NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **FRONT-OF-HOUSE**
EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Front-of-House Employees' award, dated the 22nd day of November, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 1697.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclauses (a), (b), and (f) of clause 4 (Rates of Pay), and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

“(a) The following shall be the minimum rates of wages payable to theatre attendants in picture-theatres:—

“ Adults (males)	6	1	9
“ Youths and/or females	3	17	3

“(b) Period workers shall receive 2s. 10d. per hour, with a minimum of three hours and a maximum of four hours in any one period.”

“(f) Period workers shall be paid not less than 1s. per hour extra if required to do bill-posting during the ordinary hours. If such work is done outside the ordinary hours, he shall be paid at the rate of 4s. 3d. per hour.”

(2) By deleting clause 7, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“ Rates of Pay

“ 7. The minimum wage shall be 17s. 6d. per performance.”

(3) By deleting clause 10, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“ Rates of Pay

“ 10. The minimum rates of pay shall be 8s. 6d. per performance or period, which shall not exceed three hours.”

(4) By deleting clause 16, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“ Wages

“ 16. The following shall be the minimum rate of wages payable to workers hereinafter specified:—

(5) By deleting clause 17 (Increase in Rates of Remuneration).

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
