

NEW ZEALAND **AIRCRAFT WORKERS.**—AMENDMENT OF
AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand Aircraft Workers' award, dated the 10th day of August, 1945, and recorded in 45 Book of Awards 1089.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting clause 2, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

(2) By deleting clause 6, and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“Boys and Youths

“6. The minimum weekly rates of wages payable to boys and youths employed other than as aircraft engineers’ assistants shall be in accordance with the following scale:—

“On attaining the age of twenty-one years, not less than the adult rates herein prescribed shall be paid.”

(3) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 7 (Female Workers employed by De Havilland Aircraft Co.), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) Wages:—

“And thereafter, or on attaining the age of twenty-one years, not less than £4 3s. 5d. per week.”

(4) By deleting clause 8 (Increase in Rates of Remuneration).

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
