DOMINION INDUSTRIES, LTD. (LINSEED PRODUCTS DIVISION), DUNEDIN, EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Dominion Industries, Ltd. (Linseed Products Division), Dunedin, Employees' industrial agreement, made on the 8th March, 1943, and recorded in 43 Book of Awards 582.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement (as amended by Order of the Court dated the 16th day of July, 1945) shall be further amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 4 (Wages), and substituting the following subclause:—

"(a) The minimum rates of wages shall be-

Per Hour.

"Factory workers ... 3 5³/₄

"Seed, meal, and oil store workers $3 \quad 3\frac{3}{4}$ "

(2) By deleting clause 5 (Increase in Rates of Remuneration).

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
