

NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **TAILORS**.—AMENDMENT  
OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Tailors' award, dated the 7th day of May, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 824.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum wage for men employed on weekly wages, including pressers, shall be £7 2s. 9d. per week.”

(2) By deleting the figures and symbols “2s. 3d.” in subclause (d) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the figures and symbols “2s. 6d.”

(3) By deleting the figures and symbols “3s. 4d.” in subclause (f) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the figures and symbols “3s. 8d.”

(4) By deleting subclause (b) of clause 4 (Overtime), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(b) Pieceworkers: From 6 p.m. to 9 p.m., 1s. 10½d. per hour extra, and thereafter at the rate of 3s. 8d. per hour extra. From 6 a.m. to 8 a.m., 1s. 10½d. per hour extra.”

(5) By deleting clause 6 (Increase in Rates of Remuneration).

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
