

**WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT LOCAL AUTHORITIES'
OFFICERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District Local Authorities' Officers' award, dated the 2nd day of April, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 481.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this

Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclauses (a), (b), and (d) of clause 3 (Rates and Conditions of Pay), and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

“(a) Except in the case of employees specifically classified, all male employees shall be paid in accordance with the following scale:—
