

OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND **BESPOKE TAILORS**.—AMENDMENT
OF APPRENTICESHIP ORDER

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Bespoke Tailors' apprenticeship order, dated the 11th day of February, 1925, and recorded in 25A Book of Awards 41.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Apprentices Act, 1923, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the Otago and Southland Bespoke Tailors' apprenticeship order, dated the 11th day of February, 1925, and recorded in 25A Book of Awards 41, shall be amended by inserting, after clause 8, the following new clause:—

“8A. *Exclusion from Operation of General Orders*.—The rates of remuneration provided for in this apprenticeship order shall *not* be subject to the provisions of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940, and dated the 9th August, 1940, and the 31st March, 1942, respectively.”

2. That the amendment of the said apprenticeship order dated the 8th day of April, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 117, shall be amended by revoking the declaration contained in clause 2 thereof as to the application of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940.

3. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
