

NEW ZEALAND **MOTOR TRADE EMPLOYEES.**—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand Motor Trade Employees' award, dated the 17th day of December, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 1960.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 6th day of September, 1947) shall be further amended in the manner following:—

By deleting the first paragraph of subclause (e) of clause 9, and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

“(e) *Wages.*—The minimum rates of wages shall be as follows:—

“Weekly worker substantially employed operating a Kerrick Kleaner: £7 8s. per week.

“Hourly rate for Kerrick Kleaner workers: 3s. 9½d. per hour.

“Garage attendants, weekly workers: £6 12s. 3d. per week.

“Garage attendants, hourly workers: 3s. 4¼d. per hour.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
