NORTHERN PICTURE-THEATRE MANAGERS.—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Northern Picture-theatre Managers' industrial agreement, made on the 23rd day of June, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 1185.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting the words and figures "Fourth section \dots 8 10 0" in paragraph (ii) of clause 2 (Salaries), and substituting therefor the words and figures "Fourth section \dots 9 0 0."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
