

NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **TAILORS.**—AMENDMENT  
OF AWARD .

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Tailors' award, dated the 7th day of May, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 824.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Northern Industrial District Tailors' award, dated the 7th day of May, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 824, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 23rd day of September, 1947) shall be further amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting the symbols and figures “£7 2s. 9d.” in subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the symbols and figures “£7 3s. 4d.”

(2) By deleting subclause (b) of clause 4 (Overtime), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(b) Pieceworkers: From 6 p.m. to 9 p.m., 1s. 11d. per hour extra, and thereafter at the rate of 3s. 10d. per hour extra. From 6 a.m. to 8 a.m., 1s. 11d. per hour extra.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
