## AUCKLAND FIRE BRIGADES' OFFICERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Auckland Fire Brigades' Officers' award, dated the 19th day of August, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 848.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by a party to the

Auckland Fire Brigades' Officers' award, dated the 19th day of August, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 848, this Court doth hereby order as follows:-

- 1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:-
- (1) By deleting subclauses (a), (b), and (f) of clause 1 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclauses :-
- "(a) The minimum rate of wages to be paid to the several grades of officers shall be as follows:—

"Third officer				9		

"(b) In stations where there is no mess, men not provided with married living-quarters shall be paid 5s. 3d. per week extra."

"(f) Married officers not provided with quarters shall be paid £1 5s. 3d. per week house allowance, and monthly allowances of 21s. and 4s. 9d. for fuel and light respectively."

(2) By deleting clause 2 (Increase in Rates of Remunera-

tion).

(3) By deleting the figure and symbol "5s." in subclause (a) of clause 3 (Special Duties), and substituting therefor

the figures and symbols "5s. 6d."

(4) By deleting the figures and symbol "20s." in clause 5 (Transfer), and substituting therefor the figures and

symbol "21s."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come intoforce on the 1st day of October, 1947.
