

WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT **ABATTOIR**
EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District Abattoir Employees' award, dated the 22nd day of November, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 1665.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 30th day of September, 1947) shall be further amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 5 (Special Provisions relating to Pieceworkers), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“ (a) Sheep, £3 per hundred.

“ Lambs, £2 15s. per hundred.

“ Rams and genuine stags, rate and a half.

“ Backset lambs, 10½d. each.

“ All unshorn sheep after 30th November, rate and a half.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
