- AUCKLAND GLASS-WORKS' EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF AGREEMENT UNDER LABOUR DISPUTES INVESTIGATION ACT, 1913.
- In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Auckland Glass-works' Employees' agreement under the Labour Disputes Investigation Act, 1913, made on the 2nd day of October, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 2305.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Auckland Glass-works' Employees' agreement under the Labour Disputes Investigation Act, 1913, made on the 2nd day of October, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 2305, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said agreement (as amended by order of the Court dated the 12th day of September, 1947) shall be further amended by adding to clause 11 (Bonus Rates) the following new subclause:—

" (d) All rates prescribed in subclauses (a) and (b) of this clause shall be increased by 5 per cent."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
