

**DUNEDIN FIRE-BRIGADE OFFICERS.—AMENDMENT OF
AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Dunedin Fire-brigade Officers' award, dated the 25th day of October, 1939, and recorded in 39 Book of Awards 1574.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by a party to the Dunedin Fire-brigade Officers' award, dated the 25th day of October, 1939, and recorded in 39 Book of Awards 1574, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 19th day of December, 1945) shall be further amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclauses (a) and (d) of clause 3 (Salaries), and substituting therefor the following sub-clauses:—

“(d) Married officers in residence, or within reasonable turn-out distance from the station as determined by the Superintendent, and connected by bell, and who hold themselves available to respond to emergency fire calls during leave periods between the hours of 11.30 p.m. and 7.30 a.m., shall be supplied with lighting and firing or, at the discretion of the Board, shall be paid £1 5s. 3d. per calendar month; such allowance shall include maintenance of electric-light bulbs and shades.”

(2) By inserting, after clause 3, the following new clause:—

“Exclusion from Operation of General Orders

“3A. The rates of remuneration provided for in this award shall *not* be subject to the provisions of the two general orders of the Court made under the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940, and dated the 9th August, 1940, and the 31st March, 1942, respectively.”

(3) By deleting the figure and symbol “5s.” in clause 4 (Special Duties), and substituting therefor the figures and symbols “5s. 6d.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
