WELLINGTON (UNION STEAM SHIP CO. OF NEW ZEALAND, LTD.) TUG-BOAT WORKERS.—INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Wellington Industrial District.—In the matter of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the industrial agreement, made on the 20th day of January, 1947, between the Wellington Federated Seamen's Industrial Union of Workers and the Union Steam Ship Co. of New Zealand, Ltd.

Whereas by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942 it is provided that no industrial agreement made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, shall come into force until it is filed under section 28 of the said Act: And whereas it is provided, further, that no such industrial agreement shall be accepted by a Clerk of Awards for filing as aforesaid unless it has been approved by the Court for the purposes of the said regulations: And whereas application has been made for approval of the industrial agreement made on the 20th day of January, 1947, between the Wellington Federated Seamen's Industrial Union of Workers, of the one part, and the Union Steam Ship Co. of New Zealand, Ltd., of the other part: Now, therefore, the Court, having had regard to and having

taken into consideration the matters and things as required by the said regulations, doth hereby approve the said industrial agreement for the purposes of the said regulations.

THE WELLINGTON (UNION STEAM SHIP CO. OF NEW ZEALAND, LTD.) TUG-BOAT WORKERS.—INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

This industrial agreement, made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments this 20th day of January, 1947, between the Wellington Federated Seamen's Industrial Union of Workers (hereinafter called "the union") and the Union Steam Ship Co. of New Zealand, Ltd. (hereinafter called "the employers"), whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows.

The terms, conditions, stipulations, and provisions contained and set out in an award dated 5th day of December, 1941, and recorded in Book of Awards, Volume 41, page 1815, as amended under date 15th day of February, 1946, recorded in Book of Awards, Volume 46, page 129, as amended by the undermentioned alterations, shall be deemed to have come into force on the 20th day of January, 1947, and shall continue in force until the 31st day of December, 1947.

Clause 4: Hours of Work

To be deleted, and the following substituted:-

"The ordinary hours of labour when employed in the Harbour of Wellington shall be not more than eight in a day, to be worked between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday to Friday, both inclusive."
