## NEW ZEALAND HARBOUR BOARDS' EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand Harbour Boards' Employees' award, dated the 4th day of July, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 1121.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by parties to the New Zealand Harbour Boards' Employees' award, dated the 4th day of July, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 1121, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 22nd day of September, 1947) shall be further amended by deleting from the provisions of the Appendix relating to the port of Oamaru the words and figures "Works and quarry foreman . . . 7 11 3," and substituting therefor the following:—

"Works and quarry foreman: During the period 14th July, 1947, to 30th September, 1947, £7 4s. 3d. per week (which payment shall be subject to the two general orders of the Court), and on and from the 1st October, 1947, £8 1s. 3d. per week (which payment shall not be subject to the two general orders of the Court)."

2. That this order shall come into force on the day of the date hereof, and shall have effect according to its tenor.
