

IMPERIAL CHEMICAL INDUSTRIES (NEW ZEALAND), LTD.,
METAL SLIDE FASTENER FACTORY EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Imperial Chemical Industries (New Zealand), Ltd., Metal Slide Fastener Factory Employees' industrial agreement, made on the 18th day of November, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 1998.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942 and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement (as amended by order of the Court dated the 10th day of September, 1947) shall be further amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 7 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 1947.
