

**NEW ZEALAND INSURANCE WORKERS.—AMENDMENT OF
AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand Insurance Workers' award, dated the 25th day of July, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 1257.

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this

Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 15th day of August, 1947; doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting the symbol and figure “£7” in subclause (b) of clause 1, and substituting therefor the symbols and figures “£7 12s.”

(2) By deleting subclauses (a) and (b) of clause 2, and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—
