NEW ZEALAND INSURANCE WORKERS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand Insurance Workers' award, dated the 25th day of July, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 1257.
