

NEW ZEALAND SHIPS' MASTERS AND OFFICERS (COASTAL SHIPPING COMPANIES).—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the New Zealand Ships' Masters and Officers' (Coastal Shipping Companies) award, dated the 31st day of March, 1947 (recorded in 47 Book of Awards 402).

Monday, the 19th day of May, 1947

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the New Zealand Ships' Masters and Officers' (Coastal Shipping Companies) award, dated the 31st day of March, 1947, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by inserting, after subclause (d) of clause 15 (Sundays and Holidays), the following new subclause:—

“(dd) When a vessel sails from any port on a Sunday or holiday the master and all officers shall be paid an extra day's pay.”

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
