

AUCKLAND CITY COUNCIL **DRIVERS.**—AMENDMENT OF
AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Auckland City Council Drivers' award, dated the 10th day of December, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 3127.

UPON reading the joint application of the parties for amendment of the Auckland City Council Drivers' award, dated the 10th day of December, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 3127, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 92 (1) (c) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by inserting, after clause 2, the following new clause.

“Shift Work

“2A. Drivers employed on street-sweeping machines may work shifts. Each shift shall not exceed eight hours, inclusive of one half-hour for meals, and five shifts worked between Mondays to Fridays inclusive shall constitute a week's work. Any shift starting between 3 p.m. and 6 a.m. is either an afternoon or night shift and workers employed on these shifts shall be paid 3s. per shift in addition to their ordinary rate of pay. This clause shall apply only where shifts are worked on three or more consecutive working days.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the day of the date hereof.
