

TARANAKI, WELLINGTON, MARLBOROUGH, CANTERBURY,
AND SOUTHLAND **PLACES OF AMUSEMENT (OTHER THAN
THEATRES) AND SPORTS BODIES' EMPLOYEES.—**
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Canterbury, and Southland Places of Amusement (other than Theatres) and Sports Bodies' Employees' award, dated the 8th day of December, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 2990.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 92 (1) (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and for the purpose of remedying a defect in the Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Canterbury, and Southland Places of Amusement (other than Theatres) and Sports Bodies' Employees' award, dated the 8th day of December, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 2990, this Court doth order as follows:—

1. That the said award is hereby amended by deleting from subclause (a) of clause 10 the word "less," and substituting therefor the word "more."

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
