

NEW ZEALAND **MOTOR INDUSTRY**.—DELEGATION OF POWERS
TO NEW ZEALAND MOTOR TRADE APPRENTICESHIP
COMMITTEE

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter
of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments.

PURSUANT to section 8 (1) of the Apprentices Amendment
Act, 1946, the Court doth hereby delegate to the New
Zealand Motor Trade Apprenticeship Committee, registered
on the 29th day of July, 1947, all the powers conferred on
it by paragraphs (a), (f), (g), (h), (k), and (l) of sub-
section (4) of section 5 of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and by
section 12 of the Apprentices Amendment Act, 1946, in so
far as those powers relate to the motor industry, but reserving,
nevertheless, power to the Court at any time to revoke or
vary such delegation.
