

**A. W. BRYANT, LTD., AUCKLAND, MARINE ENGINEERS.—
AGREEMENT UNDER LABOUR DISPUTES INVESTIGATION
ACT, 1913**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the agreement made on the 16th day of July, 1948, between the New Zealand Institute of Marine and Power Boat Engineers, Incorporated (Auckland Branch), and A. W. Bryant, Ltd.

WHEREAS by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942 it is provided that no agreement made in pursuance of the Labour Disputes Investigation Act, 1913, shall come into force until it is filed under section 8 of the said Act: And whereas it is provided, further, that no such agreement shall be accepted by a Clerk of Awards for filing as aforesaid unless it has been approved by the Court for the purposes of the said regulations: And whereas application has been made for approval of the agreement made on the 16th day of July, 1948; between the New Zealand Institute of Marine and Power Boat Engineers, Incorporated (Auckland Branch), of the one part, and A. W. Bryant, Ltd., of the other part: Now, therefore, the Court, having had regard to and having taken into consideration the matters and things as required by the said regulations, doth hereby approve the said agreement for the purposes of the said regulations.

**A. W. BRYANT, LTD., AUCKLAND, MARINE ENGINEERS.—
AGREEMENT UNDER LABOUR DISPUTES INVESTIGATION ACT, 1913**

THIS industrial agreement, made in pursuance of the Labour Disputes Investigation Act 1913, this 16th day of July, 1948, between the N.Z. Institute of Marine & Power Boat Engineers Incorporated (Auckland Branch), (hereinafter called "the union"), of the one part, and A. W. Bryant, Limited (hereinafter called "the employer"), of the other part, whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:—

1. That the terms, conditions, stipulations, and provisions contained in the agreement dated the 27th April, 1948, between the N.Z. Institute of Marine & Power Boat Engineers Incorporated (Auckland Branch), and the Northern Steamship Company Limited, and others shall be deemed to be and are hereby declared to form this agreement.

2. The said parties hereto shall respectively do, observe, and perform every matter and thing by this agreement and by the said terms, conditions, stipulations, and provisions respectively required to be done, observed, and performed, and shall not do anything in contravention of this agreement or of the said terms, conditions, stipulations, and provisions, but shall in all respects abide by and perform the same.

3. This agreement shall come into force on the 1st day of November, 1947, and shall continue in force until the 31st day of March, 1949.
