

**NEW ZEALAND FIRE BRIGADES' SUPERINTENDENTS AND
DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENTS—INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the industrial agreement made on the 6th day of September, 1948, between the New Zealand Fire Boards' Industrial Union of Employers and the New Zealand Fire Brigade Superintendents and Deputy Superintendents' Industrial Union of Workers.

WHEREAS by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942 it is provided that no industrial agreement made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, shall come into force until it is filed under section 28 of the said Act: And whereas it is provided, further, that no such industrial agreement shall be accepted by a Clerk of Awards for filing as aforesaid unless it has been approved by the Court for the purposes of the said regulations: And whereas application has been made for approval of the industrial agreement made on the 6th day of September, 1948, between the New Zealand Fire Boards' Industrial Union of Employers, of the one part, and the New Zealand Fire Brigade Superintendents and Deputy Superintendents' Industrial Union of Workers, of the other part: Now, therefore, the Court, having had regard to and having taken into consideration the matters and things as required by the said regulations, doth hereby approve the said industrial agreement for the purposes of the said regulations.

NEW ZEALAND FIRE BRIGADES' SUPERINTENDENTS AND DEPUTY
SUPERINTENDENTS—INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

THIS industrial agreement, made in pursuance of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments, this 6th day of September, 1948, between the New Zealand Fire Boards' Industrial Union of Employers, care First Floor, No. 8 The Terrace, Wellington (W. J. Mountjoy, Secretary), (hereinafter referred to as the "employer"), of the one part, and the New Zealand Fire Brigade Superintendents and Deputy Superintendents' Industrial Union of Workers, care Trades Hall, 126 Vivian Street, Wellington (L. Glover, Secretary), (hereinafter referred to as the "union"), of the other part, whereby it is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows, that is to say:—

1. That the terms and conditions, stipulations, and provisions contained and set out in the schedule hereto, shall be binding upon the said parties, and they shall be deemed to be and are hereby incorporated in and declared to form part of this agreement.

2. The said parties hereto shall respectively do, observe, and perform every matter and thing by this agreement and by the said terms, conditions, stipulations, and provisions respectively required to be done, observed, and performed,

and shall not do anything in contravention of this agreement or the said terms, conditions, stipulations, and provisions, but shall in all respects abide by and perform the same.

SCHEDULE

1. Hours and General Conditions

The responsibility of the Superintendents and Deputy Superintendents in relation to their duties in general, their hours and other conditions, shall remain as at present between the Superintendents, Deputy Superintendents and their respective employers, unless varied by mutual arrangement between the Superintendents, Deputy Superintendents and their respective employers.

2. Salary Payments

The following shall be the salary payments for the Superintendents and Deputy Superintendents set out herein, such payments to be made as from the 1st day of October, 1947:—

3. Scope of Agreement

This industrial agreement shall apply to the respective employers of the Superintendents and Deputy Superintendents holding office in the positions as set out in clause 2 of this agreement.

4. *Term of Agreement*

This industrial agreement shall come into force on the 6th day of September, 1948, and shall continue in force until the 6th day of September, 1950.
