

TARANAKI, WELLINGTON, MARLBOROUGH, CANTERBURY,
AND SOUTHLAND RACING, TROTTHING, AND HUNT CLUBS'
ATTENDANTS.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of an application for amendment of the Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Canterbury, and Southland Racing, Trotthing, and Hunt Clubs' Attendants' award, dated the 19th day of October, 1945, and recorded in 45 Book of Awards 1882.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by a party to the Taranaki, Wellington, Marlborough, Canterbury, and Southland Racing, Trotthing, and Hunt Clubs' Attendants' award, dated the 19th day of October, 1945, and recorded in 45 Book of Awards 1882, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 10th day of September, 1947) shall be further amended by deleting paragraph (ii) of subclause (b) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

“ (ii) Where a worker is employed for less than four hours, 3s. 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ d. an hour, with a minimum of three hours for any one period of employment.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the day of the date hereof.
