

NORTHERN, WELLINGTON, CANTERBURY, AND OTAGO AND
SOUTHLAND **WOOLLEN-MILLS AND HOSIERY-FACTORIES'**
EMPLOYEES.—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Northern, Wellington, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Woollen-mills and Hosiery-factories' Employees' award, dated the 20th day of December, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 2030.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and upon application made by a party to the Northern, Wellington, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Woollen-mills and Hosiery-factories' Employees award, dated the 20th day of December, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 2030, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 3rd day of October, 1947) shall be further amended by deleting the figures and symbols "2s. 0 $\frac{3}{4}$ d." in subclause (h) of clause 5 (Wages), and substituting therefor the figures and symbols "2s. 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ d."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 15th day of January, 1948.
