—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Northern Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Wilson's (N.Z.) Portland Cement, Ltd., Cement-workers' award, dated the 9th day of October, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 1352.

UPON reading the joint application of the parties for amendment of the Wilson's (N.Z.) Portland Cement, Ltd., Cement-workers' award, dated the 9th day of October, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 1352, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 92 (1) (c) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 29th day of September, 1947) shall be further amended by deleting paragraph 16 of subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following:—

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 22nd day of March, 1948.
