

AMENDMENT OF GENERAL ORDER AMENDING SPECIFIED
APPRENTICESHIP ORDERS

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Apprentices Act, 1923, and its amendments.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Apprentices Act, 1923, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

That the order of the Court, dated the 27th day of September, 1947 (47 Book of Awards 2113), amending several apprenticeship orders shall be amended by adding to clause 6 thereof the following proviso:—

“ Provided that this order, in so far as it relates to the Northern Industrial District Coach and Motor Body Builders' apprenticeship order, dated the 24th day of July, 1939 (39 Book of Awards 982), shall be deemed to have come into force on the 30th day of June, 1947.”
