- NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT (EXCEPT AUCKLAND (TWENTY-ONE-MILE RADIUS) AND GISBORNE JUDICIAL DISTRICT) BUTCHERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD
- In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District (except Auckland (Twenty-one-mile Radius) and Gisborne Judicial District) Butchers' award dated the 11th day of October, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 1382.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this
