NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT PUBLIC ACCOUNTANTS' CLERICAL EMPLOYEES—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942; and in the matter of the Northern Industrial District Public Accountants' Clerical Employees' award, dated the 19th day of August, 1938, and recorded in 38 Book of Awards 2163.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement, made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 11th day of September, 1947) shall be further amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 15 (Salaries), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—
