

**HAWKE'S BAY FRUIT-PACKERS, FRUIT-GRADERS, AND FRUIT
COOL-STORE WORKERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Hawke's Bay Fruit-packers, Fruit-graders, and Fruit Cool-store Workers' award, dated the 12th day of December, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 3449.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this

Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) I. Foremen, being workers in charge of two or more other workers:—

“(a) During months of January, February, June, July, August, September, October, November and December .. 3 9½

“(b) During the months of March, April, and May 4 0½

“II. (c) Certified packers:

“(d) Graders:

“(e) Cool-store men:

“All the above classes (c), (d), and (e), during the months January, February, June, July, August, September, October, November, and December .. 3 8½

“All the above classes, (c), (d), and (e), during the months of March, April, and May 3 9½

“(f) General workers 3 7¼”

(2) By deleting clause 4 and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“Youths

“4. Youths may be employed at not less than the following rates:—

“Under 16 years of age 1 18 6

“16 to 16½ years of age 2 5 6

“16½ to 17 years of age 2 12 6

“17 to 17½ years of age 2 19 0

“17½ to 18 years of age 3 5 0

“18 to 19 years of age 3 17 0

“19 to 20 years of age 4 10 0

“20 to 21 years of age 5 6 6

“The proportion of youths shall be not more than one to every four adult workers or fraction of four.”
