

CANTERBURY AND WESTLAND **PLASTERERS**—AMENDMENT
OF AWARD

[Filed in the Office of the Clerk of Awards, Christchurch]

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Canterbury and Westland Plasterers' award, dated the 21st day of February, 1946, and recorded in 46 Book of Awards 1.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 26th day of August, 1947) shall be further amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum rate of wages for all journeymen plasterers shall be 4s. 0½d. per hour. Only two classes of workmen shall be recognized—viz., journeymen and apprentices.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
