

OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND **CARDBOARD-BOX WORKERS**
(FEMALE)—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Cardboard-box Workers' (Female) award, dated the 12th day of April, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 641.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting clause 3 and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“ *Wages*

“ 3. The minimum rates of wages shall be:—

| “ And thereafter, or on attaining the age of twenty-one years, not less than .. | 4 | 10 | 9 |

“ Provided that workers commencing without previous experience at the age of eighteen years or over shall be treated as having served eighteen months.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
