TIMARU BOROUGH COUNCIL GARDENERS AND LABOURERS— AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Timaru Borough Council-Gardeners and Labourers' award, dated the 23rd day of September, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 2017.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this

Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—
- (1) By deleting subclauses (b) and (d) of clause 2 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—
- "(b) The minimum rates of pay for labourers and all other workers not specifically mentioned shall be £7 per week in the case of weekly workers, or 3s. 6d. per hour in the case of hourly workers."
- "(d) Parks, Gardens, and Reserves.—The minimum rates of wages for nurserymen, landscape gardeners, and gardeners, shall be £7 10s. 11d. per week in the case of weekly workers, or 3s. 94d. per hour in the case of hourly workers.
- "The minimum rate for gardeners' labourers shall be £7 0s. 5d. per week in the case of weekly workers, or 3s. 6d. per hour in the case of hourly workers.

- "Provided that females of the age of eighteen years and upwards shall be paid not less than £3 17s. per week for the first year and thereafter according to scale.
- "Not more than one female to every eight adult gardeners shall be employed."
- 2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
