

TARANAKI AND WELLINGTON **CHEMICAL-MANURE AND ACID WORKERS**—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

[Filed in the Office of the Clerk of Awards, New Plymouth]

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942; and in the matter of the Taranaki and Wellington Chemical-manure and Acid Workers' award, dated the 25th day of November, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 2031.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting sub-clause (a) of clause 10 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum rates of wages shall be as follows:—

“Men on super bank	3	11 $\frac{1}{2}$
“Men making or handling super-slag or basic slag mixture, either loose or in bags	3	9 $\frac{3}{4}$

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
