

OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND **LIME-WORKERS**—AMENDMENT OF  
AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Lime-workers' award, dated the 10th day of June, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 993.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this

Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting subelause (a) of clause 6 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subelause:—

“(a) The following shall be the minimum rates of wages:—

“If an unspecified worker is employed for three or more hours on any day at any of the classified operations, he shall be paid for all time worked on such day at the rate prescribed for such classified operation.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
