

NORTH ISLAND SWITCHBOARD OPERATORS—AMENDMENT
OF AWARD

[Filed in the Office of the Clerk of Awards, Auckland]

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942; and in the matter of the North Island Switchboard Operators' award, dated the 4th day of December, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 3009.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting sub-clause (a) of clause 2 (Rates of Pay) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) Rates of pay for switchboard operators shall be: for the first nine months of service, £8 3s. 4d. per week; after the first nine months of service, £8 8s. 4d. per week; subject to the special provisions of the Factories Act, 1946, and regulations thereunder, in respect of additional payments for time worked on Sundays and statutory holidays and half-holidays. (This payment is deemed to include payment for shift-work.)”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
