

**NEW ZEALAND ELECTRIC LAMP MANUFACTURERS, LIMITED,
EMPLOYEES—AMENDMENT OF AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand Electric Lamp Manufacturers, Limited, Employees' award, dated the 17th day of December, 1945, and recorded in 45 Book of Awards 2602.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 10th day of September, 1947) shall be further amended by deleting clause 5 and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“ Wages

“ 5. (a) The following rates of wages shall be paid to male workers:—

“ (b) Male adult workers of the age of twenty-one years and over shall be paid not less than 3s. 7½d. per hour.

“ (c) Men in charge of three or more workers shall be paid 2d. per hour extra.

“ (d) Female workers may be employed at not less than the following rates of wages:—

“ Under eighteen years of age: £2 9s. 6d. per week for the first six months; £2 18s. per week for the second six months; thereafter £4 12s. per week.

“ Over eighteen years of age: First six months' employment with the firm, £3 3s. 6d. per week; second six months' employment with the firm, £3 14s. 6d. per week; thereafter £4 13s. 5d. per week.

“(e) Females in charge of three or more workers shall be paid 1s. 6d. per day extra.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
