- AUCKLAND AND GISBORNE ASSISTANT STEVEDORES, FORE-MEN, AND TIMEKEEPERS—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT
- In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Auckland and Gisborne Assistant Stevedores, Foremen, and Timekeepers' industrial agreement, made on the 4th day of November, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 2232.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 6 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—
- "(a) The following shall be the minimum rate of wages (exclusive of overtime) to be paid to the respective classes of workers:—
