

DUNEDIN CITY COUNCIL (WAIPORI FALLS TEN-MILE RADIUS)
LABOURERS—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Dunedin City Council (Waipori Falls Ten-mile Radius) Labourers' industrial agreement, made on the 2nd day of December, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 3309.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 2 (Rates of Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum wages for all workers covered by the agreement shall be £7 5s. per week.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
