

**AUCKLAND CARRIERS' WHARF FOREMEN—AMENDMENT OF
AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Auckland Carriers' Wharf Foremen's award, dated the 14th day of April, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 617.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1: That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 28th day of November, 1947) shall be further

amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum wages for workers under the award shall be £8 8s. 5d. per week.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
